- Additional video coverage:

After registering for the event, we will contact you with information regarding additional video coverage of your band. We would like to get a variety of perspectives from our different programs, this can include testimonials from drum majors, seniors, captains, all sections, new marchers, band directors, parents, staff, boosters, administrators and/or invested community members. Please provide a variety of people who you think would be a good fit. We cannot guarantee that each of your selections will be chosen and highlighted, but we would like to include as many as possible. We will visit your school and record this supplemental footage.
