WHAT IS INDOOR DRUMLINE?

- Indoor Drumline consists of the marching percussion (also called battery) and front ensemble (also called pit) sections of a marching band or drum corps. Indoor percussion marries elements of music performance, marching, and theater; thus, the activity is often referred to as percussion theater.

WHAT IS INDOOR DRUMLINE?

- Thematic productions performed in a gymnasium
- Floor mat, props, uniforms, music all fit the show “theme”
- Similar to the Forney HS Marching Band “shows”, but with percussion only

WHEN WILL INDOOR DRUMLINE REHEARSE?

- The WMS Indoor Drumline will rehearse once a week, Monday afternoons from 5:00-7:30 at Forney HS

WHEN WILL INDOOR DRUMLINE PERFORM?

- There will be 4 contests this season:
 - February 8th – Rowlett HS
 - March 8th – Lewisville HS
 - March 29th – Burleson HS
 - April 5th – The OC (NTCA Championships)

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO DO INDOOR?

- Our goal every year is to make fees as low as possible so that all students can participate.
- Indoor Fees will be only \$200/student this season!
 - Fees pay for student uniforms (which they can keep), and food at contests.
 - Please don't let the cost be a reason not to do indoor! We can work something out!

WHAT DO MY FEES GO TO?


- It costs a lot of money to have an indoor drumline. Thankfully, we are receiving a ton of support from the WMS Band Boosters this season - they are paying for:
